### **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE TOURNAMENT**

1. Trophy will be awarded for winners, Runners, Third and Fourth
2. Man of the Match, Man of the Series, Best Batsman & Best Bowler will be awarded.
3. The matches will be played on a Knock-out cum league basis, and all the matches will be held at Sathyabama and Maamallan Engineering college ground.
4. Breakfast and lunch will be provided for the teams along with refreshments at the venue itself.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Participants in this tournament will be invitation only. **Entry fees: 1000/-**
2. **Match ball will be provided by the organisers.**
3. Only bonafide and regular students of **B.E/B.Tech and MBBS,BDS** will be allowed from the respective college teams
4. Participants are requested to produce their identity cards at the time of the match and also have to come with proper cricketing uniform.
5. Each team will comprise of a maximum **16 players** accompanied by a Manger/Director of Physical Education who will be responsible for the conduct of the team
6. Each college must send only one team
7. The matches will be played on 20 over's a side, in which a bowler can bowl maximum of 4 over's.
8. **Matches start at 7 A.M in the morning and 1.00 P.M in the afternoon**
9. Matches could be reduced or curtailed, in a case of rain/ any other unforeseen situations, at the discretion of the organizing committee in consultation with umpires.
10. The Umpires are empowered to rearrange the number of over's to be bowled by each side for the delayed start or if the play is held up in between.
11. The tournament committee reserves the right of changes the venue, time, date and any other matter connected with tournament.
12. All the teams have to bring their own kits.
13. Umpire's decision is final. No protest will be entertained.
14. The final decision, in any matters rest with the organizing committee
15. **Players are not allowed in casuals (T shirts & jeans) inside the campus .**
16. **Smoking and any other indiscipline activity strictly prohibited inside the campus.**
17. **Use of Mobile Phones strictly prohibited inside the campus.**
