3. The form should be attested by the Placement Officer, respective HODs' and Dean Higher studies.



4. Photocopy of the scores of the qualifying examinations (GRE / GMAT / TOEFL / IELTS) must be attached with the higher studies form.

5. Hardcopy of the recommendation letter should be approved by the respective faculty members.

6. Name of the recommender with his / her qualification, his / her designation, department, personal email id and date of issue of recommendation letter should be clearly mentioned in the hardcopy of the recommendation letter. (Refer: SAMPLE LETTER).

- Once approved and signed by the faculty member, further corrections will not be made in the letter.
- Softcopy (Only through mail (advisorybureau@gmail.com/ STRICTLY NO PENDRIVE) should be given for taking the printout.
- Maximum number of copies 15 (5 per each recommender)


