


Report on World Wetlands Day

The theme for the 2022 edition was Wetlands Action for People and Nature, and it highlights the importance of actions that ensure that wetlands are conserved and sustainably used. As part of which an exclusive webinar session was organized by the Centre for Climate Change Studies, Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology, Chennai.


Environment enthusiasts, school and college students, and research scholars from various institutions across the country participated in the event.






Report on World TB Day 2022



The Participants were provided with an appreciation certificate for their participation and performance. The Event concluded with a Vote of Thanks.






Report on International day for Biological Diversity 2022


National webinar on 'Indian Microbial Wealth' was conducted by the Centre for Drug Discovery and Development, Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology on 24th May, 2022 between 10:00 AM and 12:30 PM, in commemoration of International Day for Biological Diversity. 


