- Author names: Bold, Times New Roman, 12 size, must include affiliation. Underline the presenting author and provide email.
- Abstract: Regular, Times New Roman, 12 size (Paragraph style), 1.5 line spacing (up to 300 words).
- Add suitable keywords (up to 5).
- Submitted abstracts will be assigned for ORAL or POSTER presentation by the committee.
