Dr.B.Sheela Rani, Convener & Member Secretary welcomed the members of the Board. Dr.T.Sasipraba, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed the members of the board and addressed the gathering.

The Convener of the Board briefed on the PhD admissions that had happened for the last semester July 2024 batch and also the supervisors who have got the eligibility for recognition during this period. The recipient of the Col. Dr.Jeppiaar best thesis Award during the convocation in the month of August 2024, was also presented. The status of the defending viva voce conducted so far and the action taken in the last board of research meeting was also briefed.

Academic Research activities for the period March 2024 – November 2024

Ph.D Admissions

For the session July 2024, admissions as per the UGC procedures of conducting the entrance examination and screening presentation in the 70 percentage 30 percentage basis, which we have conducted in our University campus on **4th May, 2024**. Out of 75 applications received, based on their performance, **61 candidates** have been selected. **19 candidates** have registered under Full-Time mode, and **42 Candidates** have registered under Part-Time mode.

Supervisor Recognition:

With the criterion, for recognition as Supervisor, after one year of completion of PhD with some research activity being carried out with a publication is being considered. So with these norms, **25 Faculty** have been recognized as supervisors for the period Jan 2024 to June 2024. **13** from Faculty of Computer Science and Engineering, **1** from Faculty of Electronics Engineering, **1** from Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, **1** from Faculty of Chemical Engineering **1** from Management **1** from Faculty of Commerce **1** from Faculty of Interdisciplinary **1** from Faculty of Science (Chemistry), **4** from Faculty of Science (Life Sciences), **1** from Faculty of Science (Visual Communication).

Award of Ph.D Degree (2023 – 2024) / Status of Defending Viva Voce Examination (2024 – 2025)

For the academic year **2023 – 2024**, Convocation was held on **18th August, 2024**. 122 Candidates have been awarded with Ph.D degree. "**Col.Dr.Jeppiaar Best Thesis Award**" has been awarded to **Dr.A.Vinuganesh**, under the Faculty of Science (Life Sciences) based on the criterion – Publications, Impact on Research, Impact on Society and Thesis Evaluation comments received from Indian and Foreign Examiners, with approval from Board of Research Members.

For the academic year 2024 – 2025, to till date, 07 candidates have completed the defending Viva Voce successfully. Indian and Foreign Examiners reports have been received for 11 Candidates and are yet to conduct Viva Voce.

- Undertaking from candidate and also host institute's permission are to be obtained if admission is granted as per SIST norms.
- The availability of infrastructure facility for conducting the topic of research by the candidate under the guidance of the supervisor may be assured at SIST or the host institute where the candidate belongs to.
- In the absence of no clear-cut guidelines for admitting the candidate, the approval of competent authority as a special case shall be obtained from UGC.

The above points are my views and the suggestions from other BoR members may please be invited for admitting this candidate.

Dr.Pradeep Kumar approved for the candidate to carry out Ph.D in Faculty of Science (Life Sciences).

Dr.Mukesh Doble suggested the following

- The candidate can carry out Ph.D in Faculty of Science (Life Sciences)

Dr.Alagar suggested to register under the 'Faculty of Science' (Life Science stream) as per norms.

Dr.Mathirajan suggested that as long as the research-scholar and guide are matching in relevant discipline (that is, the domain area of research is matching both scholar and the guide), to accept the registration.

The same has been presented and as per the suggestions, Dr.Anima Nanda as Supervisor and One Doctoral Committee member from Faculty of Dental Surgery is adopted.

Action Taken : Letter sent through registered post on 6-1-2022. No reply from the candidate, hence registration had been cancelled in the 21st BOR meeting held on 9th April 2022.

Now the candidate is approaching for conduct of Viva Voce in November 2024

Special case regarding delay in thesis submission

1 Scopus journal, 1 conference has been published and 1 WoS publication is pending. The candidate has submitted the thesis and synopsis by May 2022. Resigned from University. It is not processed for thesis evaluation as 1 publication is awaited.

- Decision requested

Dr.Mathirajan is of the opinion that publication should not become a bottle neck for submission of thesis if quantum of work is there in the thesis. As long as she has few publications, an expert committee can be formed and decided whether the thesis is worth sending to examiner with the publications carried out.

Dr.Alagar, Dr.Pradeep Kumar, Dr.Govindaraj, Dr.Raj Vikram suggested that the norms followed by the university for submission of thesis is to be followed.

Dr.S.SRao, suggested to constitute a committee and to check if one more publication is required.(not necessarily to be indexed).

Based on the discussions, it is decided to **constitute a committee** and check for the necessity of publication and worthiness to send the thesis for evaluation by examiners.

Received the reports from Indian and Foreign examiner. The Indian examiner had recommended the thesis, whereas the foreign examiner denied the recommendation and instructed the candidate to incorporate the suggested modifications in the thesis and the corrected thesis along with the candidate's clarifications shall be sent to him for further evaluation.

The reports had been sent to the candidate on 13th February 2023. The candidate had not submitted the revised thesis till now and assured for submission by end of November 2024.

Dr. Alagar suggested to give a chance even though there is a delay in submitting the revised thesis. He advised to send an official letter of request to examiners justifying candidates publication and the reason for the delay.

Dr. Govindaraj enquired whether the thesis will be sent to the same examiner. If examiner has the intention to evaluate, asked to proceed for evaluation and to take the opinion of the examiner.

Based on the discussion, it is decided to **collect the revised thesis** from the candidate **before December 2024** and send it for evaluation with an **official letter** mentioning the justification for delay and recommending to evaluate for having given sufficient publications in indexed journals and in International and National Conferences.

Dr. Govindaraj, Dr. Pradeep Kumar, Dr. S.S. Rao also suggested to follow the above procedure for admission to Ph.D candidates with distance education.

Dr. T. Sasipraba suggested to encourage distance education as UGC is offering more Online education from 2021 onwards and to screen them based on the Entrance test conducted by University.

Dr. Mathirajan informed that distance education is meant for job opportunities and promotions. For research to maintain the quality and also to enable to good publications advised to stick to qualified NET/SLET candidates if completing in distance education mode.

Dr. Alagar also recommended the same.

Based on the discussions it is decided to consider candidates with **distance education** if they are **qualified in NET/SLET examination**.

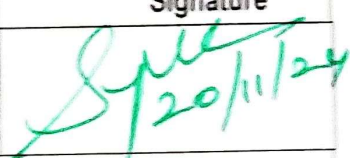
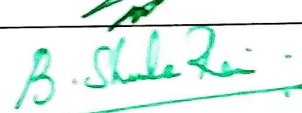
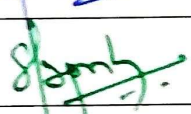
